

Balnabruach Bones - Report Summary

- Burial C (+D) - Burial aligned East to West with head to West end
Stone lined grave cut with body laid on to gravel
Aged 16-25 5ft 6 inches tall
Probably male BUT D=Female Characteristics
Young skeleton with male characteristics not rally formed
It is thought that some bones logged as D were mixed during excavation therefore D female 16-20 bones belong to Burial C.
- Burial Dii (+Bii) Found between lower limbs of Burial C
Possibly Male adult
Taller than 5ft 2 inches
- Burial B Aligned north to south with head to the south
Stratigraphically lower than Burials C & D
Remains seem to have been greatly disturbed by Machine
Female in Late 30s
5ft 2 inches tall
- Burial A Thought to be from a short cist
Skeleton in crouched position
Young Adult possibly Male
Aged 17-25 years
